The House Committee on Transportation, Mobility and Infrastructure was called to order by Chair Shannon.

The Chair laid SB 533 before the committee:

SB 533 (Sen. Geiss)

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code," by amending sections 217, 222, and 233a (MCL 257.217, 257.222, and 257.233a), sections 217 and 233a as amended by 2022 PA 224 and section 222 as amended by 2014 PA 290.

Representative Conlin moved to adopt the meeting minutes from October 24, 2023. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

Brian Merlos, representing the Office of Senator Geiss, and Melissa Horste, representing the Michigan Department of State, testified in support of SB 533. Questions and discussion followed.
