The Chair laid HB 4826 before the committee:

HB 4826

(Rep. Brann) A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code," by amending section 1278 (MCL 380.1278), as amended by 2016 PA 170, and by adding section 1166b.

Substitute (H-1) of HB 4856 was adopted on October 29, 2019.

Representative Vaupel moved to adopt substitute (H-1) to HB 4826. The motion prevailed 15-0-0:
