COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

The House Standing Committee on Ways and Means was called to order by the Chair Iden.

Representative Warren moved to adopt the meeting minutes from June 4, 2019. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

The Chair laid SB 0192 and SB 0193 before the committee:

SB 0192 (Sen. Victory) A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code," by amending section 310e (MCL 257.310e), as amended by 2015 PA 11.

SB 0193 (Sen. Victory) A bill to amend 2006 PA 384, entitled "Driver education provider and instructor act," by amending section 39 (MCL 256.659), as amended by 2010 PA 16.

Representative Lilly moved to report out SB 0192 with recommendation. The motion prevailed 10-0-0.

HB 4408 (Rep. Miller) A bill to amend 2000 PA 321, entitled "Recreational authorities act," by amending section 27 (MCL 123.1157).

The Chair laid HB 4336 and HB 4574 before the committee:

HB 4336 (Rep. S. Johnson) A bill to amend 2003 PA 1, entitled "An act to provide for the audit and examination of this state and state funds; to provide for the audit and examination of the books and accounts of all branches, departments, offices, boards, commissions, agencies, authorities, and institutions of this state; to prescribe powers and duties of certain state officers and employees; to provide for access to certain records; to provide for the subpoena of witnesses and production of documents and records; to prescribe penalties; and to provide for the administration of this act," by amending the title and section 1 (MCL 13.101).

HB 4574 (Rep. LaGrand) A bill to amend 1846 RS 1, entitled "Of the statutes," (MCL 8.1 to 8.9) by adding section 6a.

Representative Hauck moved to report out HB 4336 with recommendation. The motion prevailed 10-0-0.
