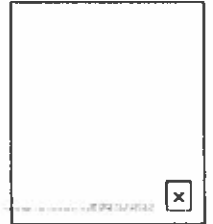

Good Evening Representative Sleeper,

I am writing to you tonight in support of HB 4688, which would make minimum staffing a mandatory bargaining item for firefighter with their administration. This is something that is very important to firefighters and the community. The main way that it can cause major repercussions in any community is when an administration tries to find ways to cut the budget and ends up lowering the minimum staffing requirement. This puts the firefighters at risk and the community that we serve. National Firefighting Standards that is put in place by the NFPA calls for a minimum of 15 firefighters to be dispatched to a house fire to best protect lives and property. The is for a low hazard type of incident. NFPA Standard 1710 states the following:

Initial Alarm Deployment (number of firefighters including officers)

Low hazard = 15 firefighters

Medium hazard = 28 firefighters

High hazard = 43 firefighters

Giving city and township administration, ones who have generally never been on a fireground, put on firefighting gear, or fought a house fire, the opportunity to cut minimum staffing without bargaining with the firefighters (bargaining unit) puts the lives of firefighters at risk, property at risk of being lost, and lives at risk of not being saved. How would any of you feel if you had a house fire and the first fire engine to pull up only had two firefighters because the city or township administration wanted to save money in the budget and not have adequate firefighters on staff. This happens all too often and causes fire departments to rely on mutual aid agreements.

With a mutual aid agreement, more firefighters may come, but there many variables in relying on that as well. Some stations in other departments may be further away from the incident causing long response times of 10 minutes or more. A fire doubles in size every minute. Some departments in surrounding areas are not full-time staffed and rely on paid-on-call staff who are volunteer members who respond from home. That would add at least five minutes to the already at least 10 minute response from a mutual aid department. In that time, the two to four firefighters on location can be dire need of help or it could cause your home or loved ones to succumb to the fire.

With all of that being said, I ask you to reconsider your stance and support and approve HB 4688. Please allow our firefighters to be able to work with city and township administration to compromise minimum staffing. Please let us fight for our lives and the lives and property of our communities as we do every time we answer a call for help. Thank you for your time and consideration.

My name is Michael Siburt, I am a Southfield firefighter Local 1029. I am writing this email in support of House bill 4688. Minimum staffing levels should absolutely be a mandatory subject of bargaining. We need more staffing within the fire department. Here is a good example of why that is needed.

In 2022, I was on the job for roughly 6 months with Southfield fire department, I was on the Engine (fire truck) with 1 other person. Our stations have 4 firefighters, 2 on the engine and 2 on the ambulance. The ambulance was on a medical call. We got called on a house fire with a trapped victim. My partner and I were on scene within minutes and we were the only 2 firefighters on scene for a little while while other trucks were responding from other stations. When we exited the truck, we had family members yelling at us that their mother was trapped inside the house. We strapped on our SCBA (air pack) and entered the house to search for the victim without the protection of a hose. That is because we didnt have anyone to run the pump on the engine to send us water because we both had to search the home for a victim. If we had more staffing, we could have had someone to run the pump and able to enter the home with protection of the hose line due to the fire load in the home. It is very dangerous for us to enter a home that is on fire without a hose to protect us from the fire while searching for victims trapped in a house fire. This situation put me and my partner at risk, along with the victim that we were searching for. The citizens deserve to know that their fire departments are well staffed and are able to protect them to the best of the ability with proper staffing levels.

If we would have had 4 people on the fire engine, we could have had someone running the pump, someone controlling the hose and the other 2 people searching for the victim. Proper staffing needs to be mandatory for bargaining units. We shouldn't have to go to work everyday not knowing if we are going to be able to come home the next day or not due to low staffing levels and the dangers of having to enter structure fires with little help.

Please help us PASS house bill 4688 and give all firefighters proper staffing so we can go home to our families.
