Representative Lisa Posthumus Lyons, Chair, called the meeting to order.

Representative Franz moved to approve the minutes from the April 30, 2014 meeting.

There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

Representative Franz moved to excuse the absent member from the day's meeting.

There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

ABSENT/EXCUSED MEMBERS: Representatives Daley and Stallworth.

The Chair laid HB 5223 and HB 5224 before the committee:

HB 5223 (O'Brien) Education; teachers; performance evaluation requirements for teachers; revise.

HB 5224 (Zemke) Education; employees; performance evaluation requirements for school administrators; revise.

Donald Heller, Dean, College of Education, representing Michigan State University, testified in opposition to HB 5223 and HB 5224.

David Manson, representing the VanBuren Intermediate School District and himself, testified in support of HB 5223 and HB 5224.

The committee went at ease at 8:48 a.m.

The committee reconvened at 8:55 a.m.

Representative McMillin offered and moved to adopt the following amendment to HB 5223 (H-4):

1. Amend page 3, line 26, after "**2015-2016**," by inserting "**NOT LESS THAN 1% OF THE ANNUAL YEAR-END EVALUATION AND NOT MORE THAN**".

The motion did not prevail by a vote of 7-6-1.
