

**MINUTES OF THE COMMITTEE

The House Committee on Appropriations was called to order by the Chairman, Representative Joe Haveman.

Representative Pscholka moved to approve the minutes of September 17, 2014.

There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

The Chair laid Legislative Transfer 2014-8 before the committee.

Viola Wild and Robin Risko, House Fiscal Agency, explained the transfer package.

Kyle Kaminski, Michigan Department of Corrections, answered questions for the committee regarding the transfer package.

Paul Holland, House Fiscal Agency, explained a proposed amendment to the transfer package.

Representative Potvin moved to amend to the transfer package (amendment attached).

The motion prevailed by a vote of 28-0-0.

HB 4157 (Poleski) State financing and management; funds; information, communication, and technology innovation revolving fund; create.

Marilyn Peterson, House Fiscal Agency, explained the bill to the committee members.

Scott Starr, Michigan Department of Technology, Management and Budget, testified in support of the bill.

Deena Bosworth, Michigan Association of Counties, submitted a card in support of the bill but did not wish to speak.

Andy Solon, representing AT&T, submitted a card indicating a neutral position on HB 4157 but did not wish to speak.

Representative Muxlow moved to adopted substitute (H-2) to HB 4157.

The motion prevailed by a vote of 25-1-1.

HB 5725 (Haveman) Property; conveyances; conveyance of surplus state-owned real estate; enact procedures for conveyance.

Ben Gielczyk, House Fiscal Agency, explained the bill for the committee.

Chairman Haveman moved to adopted substitute (H-1) to HB 5725.

The motion prevailed by a vote of 26-0-0.

Scott Starr and Bob Burns, Michigan Department of Technology, Management and Budget, answered questions for the committee members.

Representative Shirkey moved to amend HB 5725 (H-1) as follows:

1. Amend page 7, following line 14 by inserting:

**“(18) THIRTY DAYS BEFORE CONVEYING OR TRANSFERRING PROPERTY UNDER THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOTIFY EACH MEMBER OF THE SENATE AND HOUSE APPROPRIATION COMMITTEES OF THE INTENT TO CONVEY OR TRANSFER THE PROPERTY AND THE TERMS OF THE PROPOSED CONVEYANCE OR TRANSFER. IF THE SENATE AND HOUSE APPROPRIATION COMMITTEES VOTE TO DISAPPROVE THE CONVEYANCE OR TRANSFER WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE NOTICE UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT CONVEY OR TRANSFER THE PROPERTY. THIS SUBSECTION ONLY APPLIES TO PROPERTY WITH A FAIR MARKET VALUE OR AN APPRAISED VALUE OF MORE THAN \$250,000”** and renumbering the remaining subsections.

The motion prevailed by a vote of 21-1-4.

Representative Durhal moved to amend HB 5725 (H-1) as follows:

1. Amend page 6, following line 6, by inserting:

**“(E) THE LAND BANK FAST TRACK AUTHORITY CREATED UNDER SECTION 15 OF THE LAND BANK FAST TRACK ACT, 2003 PA 258, MCL 124.765.”.**

2. Amend page 6, line 9, after “(11)” by inserting **“THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A JURISDICTIONAL TRANSFER OF PROPERTY EXEMPTED UNDER SUBSECTION (11)(E).”.**

The motion prevailed by a vote of 22-2-2.
