| SB 527 | (Caswell) | Civil procedure; costs and fees; fees for actions involving child custody, support, or parenting time; require payment at time action is filed. |
| SB 528 | (Nofs) | Gaming; lottery; distribution of lottery winnings for child support arrearages; update to reflect payment to the state disbursement unit. |
| SB 529 | (Caswell) | Family law; child support; allocation and distribution determination authority; modify. |
| SB 530 | (Caswell) | Family law; friend of the court; powers and duties of office of child support; modify, and provide other general amendments. |
