HB 5347 (Haines)	Mental health; developmental disability; reference to mentally retarded and mental retardation; change to developmental disability.
HB 5348 (Leonard)	Mental health; developmental disability; reference to mentally retarded and mental retardation; change to developmental disability.
HB 5349 (Cotter)	Mental health; developmental disability; reference to mentally retarded in revised judicature act; replace with developmentally disabled.
HB 5350 (Cochran)	Children; other; reference to mentally retarded and mental retardation; modify.
HB 5351 (Knezek)	Mental health; developmental disability; reference to mentally retarded children to developmentally disabled children; modify.
HB 5352 (Somerville)	Mental health; developmental disability; reference to mentally retarded; change to developmentally disabled.
