1. Amend page 3, line 3, after "**THIS**" by striking out "**SUBDIVISON**" and inserting "**SUBDIVISION**".

**"(2) FOR ALL PRINTING DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1), ALL OTHER THINGS BEING EQUAL, PREFERENCE SHALL BE GIVEN FOR PRINTING OFFERED BY MICHIGAN-BASED FIRMS OR BY FACILITIES WITH RESPECT TO**

**WHICH THE OPERATOR IS DESIGNATED AS A CLEAN CORPORATE CITIZEN UNDER PART 14 OF THE NATURAL RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT, 1994 PA 451, MCL 324.1401 TO 324.1429."**

7. Amend page 4, line 18, by inserting “or”.
8. Amend page 4 line 18, after “policy” by striking out “or resolution”.
