



Representative Dianda withdrew his amendments to House Bill 5361 (H-1).

**Representative Rendon moved to report House Bill 5361 with the recommendation that the substitute (H-1) be adopted and that the bill then pass.**

The Chair laid before the committee Senate Bill 759

**SB 759 (Casperson)** Natural resources; hunting; prohibition on person holding a fur dealer's license from holding a license to trap beaver; remove.

Kendra Everett, Legislative Director for the bill sponsor, explained the bill to the committee members. Ms. Everett answered questions following her introduction of the bill.

Dale Hendershot, President of the Michigan Trappers and Predator Callers, testified in support of the bill. Mr. Hendershot responded to questions from committee members.

Trevor VanDyke, Legislative Liaison and Policy Advisor for the Michigan Department of Natural Resources, came forth to address questions from committee members. Mr. VanDyke referred to Mr. Adam Bump, Bear and Furbearer Specialist for the Michigan Department of Natural Resources, to respond to a member's questions.

Amy Trotter, Resource Policy Manager for Michigan United Conservation Clubs, submitted a testimony card in support of the bill, but did not wish to testify.

The Chair laid before the committee House Bill 4874

**HB 4874 (Goike)** Environmental protection; sewage; requirement to dispose of septage waste at receiving facilities; eliminate sunset on exemption for owners of certain storage facilities.

Representative Goike, the bill sponsor, explained the need for the bill to committee members. Jack Kelly, Elmwood Township Supervisor and Chair of the Grand Traverse County Board of Public Works, testified in opposition to the bill. Mr. Kelly addressed questions from committee members following his testimony. A copy of his handout is attached.

Chuck Korn, Garfield Charter Township Supervisor, testified in opposition to the bill. Following his testimony, Mr. Korn answered questions from committee members.

Glen Lile, East Bay Charter Township, testified in opposition to the bill, and spoke to the questions from a committee member. A copy of his handout is attached.

Tom Frazier, Legislative Liaison for the Michigan Townships Association, testified in opposition to the bill. Mr. Frazier addressed questions from committee members.

Dave W. Snyder, Vice President of West Michigan Septic, Sewer and Drain Service, testified in support of the bill, and responded to questions following his testimony

Joseph Hall, President of the Michigan Septic Association, testified in support of the bill. Mr. Hall addressed questions of committee members.
