

**MINUTES OF THE COMMITTEE
ON

The House Standing Committee on Regulatory Reform was called to order by the Chair.

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| SB 575 | (Schuitmaker) | Occupations; health care professions; disciplinary subcommittees; provide for removal of members for conflicts of interest. |
| SB 576 | (Schuitmaker) | Public employees and officers; ethics; penalties for noncompliance with conflict of interest disclosure; implement into statute. |
| SB 577 | (Jones) | Occupations; health care professions; grounds for administrative sanctions; expand for licensed health professionals. |
| SB 578 | (Jones) | Health; occupations; decisions of disciplining subcommittees; establish process for review before decision is final. |

SB 329 (Hildenbrand) Liquor; other; provision regarding the acquisition, sale, development, or operation of real property to another vendor by a brewer; expand to include wine maker, distiller, or brandy manufacturer and limit the number of real properties.

Fred Chaible, representing Senator Hildenbrand's office, and Bob Jacobson, representing Leelanau Cellars, testified in support of the bill. Questions and discussion followed.

The Chair laid the committee at ease, the time being 9:18 a.m.

The Chair brought the committee back to order, the time being 9:24 a.m.

Julie Wendt, representing the Michigan Liquor Control Commission, submitted a card with a neutral position on the bill, but did not wish to speak.

The Chair laid HB 5284 before the committee:

HB 5284 (Lane) Occupations; residential builders; relicensing of certain formerly licensed residential builders and residential maintenance and alteration contractors; expand authority of board.

Representative Lane testified in support of her bill. Questions and discussion followed.

Kit Murphy, representing the Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, submitted a card in support of the bill, but did not wish to speak.

Representative McBroom moved to approve the minutes of the February 18, 2014 meeting. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

There being no further business before the committee, the Chair adjourned the meeting at 9:34 a.m.
