The House Standing Committee on Commerce and Trade was called to order by **Representative Joseph Graves**, Chair.

SB 331 (Jones) Occupations; business licensing and registration; used motor vehicle parts dealers; require certain forms of payment for used tires, wheels, and rims.

1. Amend page 2, line 5, after "processor" by inserting "**OR AUTOMOTIVE RECYCLER**".
