HOUSE STANDING COMMITTEE ON HEALTH POLICY

HB 4206 (Geiss)	Health; other; human breast milk banks, companies, and cooperatives; regulate.
HB 4691 (Geiss)	Health; other; Internet sale of human breast milk; prohibit.
HB 5547 (Darany)	Criminal procedure; sentencing guidelines; sentencing guidelines for crimes involving the provision of raw human milk for human consumption; provide for.
