HOUSE STANDING COMMITTEE ON HEALTH POLICY

Tuesday, September 29th, 2015 9:00 a.m. Room 519 House Office Building

Representative Callton, Chair, called the meeting to order.

Chair Callton requested attendance be called to establish a quorum of the appointed committee members:

Representative Vaupel moved to approve the minutes from the September 22nd, 2015, meeting.

There being no objection, the motion was approved by unanimous consent.

The Chair laid HB 4674 before the committee:

HB 4674 (Leonard) Mental health; code; assisted outpatient treatment program; modify.

A substitute (H-1) was adopted for HB 4674 on September 22nd, 2015.

Representative Vaupel offered the following amendment to HB 4674 as substituted (H-1):

1. Amend page 48, line 15, by striking out all of enacting section 2 and inserting:
"Enacting section 2. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days after the date it is enacted into law or April 1, 2016, whichever is later."

Representative Darany moved to adopt the amendment. The motion prevailed by a vote of 20-0-0.

HB 4206 (Geiss) Health; other; human breast milk banks, companies, and cooperatives; regulate.

HB 4691 (Geiss) Health; other; Internet sale of human breast milk; prohibit.

Representative Geiss, Cindy Duff, representing Mothers Milk Bank, Kendra Rowser, representing the Black Mothers Breast Feeding Association, and Tim Michling, from the office of Representative Geiss, testified in support of the bills. Questions and discussion followed.
