MINUTES OF THE COMMITTEE
ON
JUDICIARY

Tuesday, June 16, 2015 12:00 p.m. Room 521 House Office Building

The House Standing Committee on Judiciary was called to order by Chairman Kesto.

Members present: Reps. Kesto, Lucido, Heise, Johnson, Howrylak, Cole, Runestad, Irwin, Robinson, Chang, Guerra.

Members absent/excused: None.

Representative Lucido moved to adopt the minutes of June 9, 2015. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

Chairman Kesto laid the following bill before the committee:

HB 4535 (Theis) Weapons; licensing; purchase permit process; exempt law enforcement officers.

Representative Theis and Mike Kinaschuk, representing the Livingston County Sheriff's Department, gave an overview of the bill. Questions and discussion followed.

The following individuals submitted cards on the bill but did not wish to speak:

Ben Bodkin, representing the Michigan Sheriffs' Association, support.

Tim Ward, representing the Police Officers Association of Michigan, support.

Representative Lucido offered the following amendments to HB 4535:

1. Amend page 2, line 7, after "**(D)**" by striking out the balance of the subdivision and inserting "**AN INDIVIDUAL CURRENTLY EMPLOYED AS A POLICE OFFICER, CERTIFIED UNDER THE COMMISSION ON LAW ENFORCEMENT STANDARDS ACT, 1965 PA 203, MCL 28.601 TO 28.616**".

2. Amend page 4, following line 25, by inserting:
"Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days after the date it is enacted into law.".

Representative Heise moved to adopt the amendments to the bill. The motion prevailed 10-1-0.

SB 281 (Schuitmaker) Courts; district court; reallocation of portion of certain filing fees paid to the Wayne County retirement system for bailiffs in the thirty-sixth district court under certain circumstances; provide for.

Trisha Brumley, representing Senator Tonya Schuitmaker, and Judge Michael Talbot, gave an overview of the bill. Questions and discussion followed.

Representative Heise moved to report out SB 281 with recommendation. The motion prevailed 9-0-2.
