MINUTES OF THE COMMITTEE

JUDICIARY

The House Standing Committee on Judiciary was called to order by Chairman Kesto.

Members present: Reps. Kesto, Lucido, Heise, Johnson, Howrylak, Cole, Runestad, Irwin, Robinson, Chang, Guerra.

Representative Lucido moved to adopt the minutes of October 13, 2015. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

Chairman Kesto laid the following bill before the committee:

HB 4680 (Pagel) Corrections; other; authority for correctional industries to engage in certain private manufacturing or service enterprises; extend sunset.

Representative Pagel and Kyle Kaminski, representing the Michigan Department of Corrections, testified in support of the bill. Questions and discussion followed.

Representative Lucido moved to report out HB 4680 with recommendation. The motion prevailed, the vote being 11-0-0.

Representative Heise moved to report out SB 225 with recommendation. The motion prevailed, the vote being 9-1-1.
