The Chair laid before the committee House Bill 4814.

**HB 4814 (Runestad)** Public employees and officers; state; posting of organization charts for each state department; require.

The committee previously met on this bill on Thursday, October 22, 2015.

The Chair offered the substitute (H-1) for House Bill 4814.

**Representative Theis moved to adopt the substitute (H-1) for House Bill 4814.**

**The motion prevailed by an affirmative vote of a majority of the members appointed to and serving on the committee, voting as follows:**

**Yeas: Representatives McBroom, Howrylak, Graves, Theis, Robinson, and Pagan, (6/6)**

**Nays: None. (0)**

The substitute was adopted.

Representative Runestad, the bill sponsor, explained the bill with a PowerPoint presentation, and introduced his Legislative Director, Krista Jones, who did a PowerPoint demonstration on what the public can presently access. Copies are attached.

Matthew Sweeney, Legislative Liaison and Policy Advisor in the Director's Office of the Michigan Department of Technology, Management and Budget, submitted a testimony card in support of the bill as substituted, but did not wish to speak.

**Representative Pagan moved to report House Bill 4814 with the recommendation that the substitute (H-1) be adopted and that the bill then pass.**

**HB 5464 (McBroom)** Legislature; auditor general; authority to obtain confidential or electronic data; provide for.

**Representative Graves moved to report House Bill 5464 without amendment and with the recommendation that the bill pass.**

The bill was referred to the full House.
