The House Standing Committee on Oversight and Ethics was called to order by Representative Ed McBroom, Chair.

The Clerk called the roll; members present were **Representatives McBroom, Howrylak, Graves, Theis, Robinson, and Pagan. (6/6)**

The Clerk announced that a quorum was present.

The Chair laid before the committee the minutes of June 2, 2016

Representative Pagan moved to adopt the minutes of June 2, 2016 as printed.

There being no objection the motion prevailed by unanimous consent of the members present; the minutes were adopted as printed.

The Chair laid before the committee the minutes of May 26, 2016 as amended.

The Chair read a proposed section of the minutes stating there was an error with Representative Howrylak making a motion and asked for motion to amend the language to that section with Representative McBroom making the motion to adopt the substitute.

Representative Theis moved to adopt the minutes of May 26, 2016 as amended.

There being no objection the motion prevailed by unanimous consent of the members present; the minutes were adopted as amended.

The Chair laid before the committee House Bills 4748 and 4749.

HB 4748 (Kivela)

Corrections; state facilities; inspection of prison kitchen facility managed by private contractor; require.

HB 4749 (McBroom)

Food; other; exemption of a prison where private contractors serve food regulated as a food establishment; remove.

Representative Robinson moved to report House Bill 4748 without amendment and with the recommendation that the bill pass.

The motion prevailed by an affirmative vote of a majority of the members appointed to and serving on the committee, voting as follows:

Yeas: Representatives McBroom, Howrylak, Graves, Theis, Robinson, and Pagan, (6/6)

Nays: None. (0/6)

The bill was referred to the full House.

Representative Howrylak moved to report House Bill 4749 without amendment and with the recommendation that the bill pass.

The motion prevailed by an affirmative vote of a majority of the members appointed to and serving on the committee, voting as follows:

Yeas: Representatives McBroom, Howrylak, Graves, Theis, Robinson, and Pagan, (6/6)

Nays: None. (0/6)

The bill was referred to the full House.

Jeremy Trip, Director of Government and Political Affairs for Michigan Corrections Organization, submitted a testimony card in support of the bills, but did not wish to speak.

There being no other business before the committee; **Representative Pagan moved to adjourn the meeting.**
