HOUSE STANDING COMMITTEE ON REGULATORY REFORM

Wednesday, May 11th, 2016 12:00 Noon Room 519 House Office Building

Representative Ray A. Franz, Chair, called the meeting to order.

Chair Franz requested attendance be called to establish a quorum of the appointed committee members:

Present: Reps. Franz, Yonker, Kesto, Lauwers, Iden, Howell, Dianda, Darany, Lane, Schor, Chirkun, and Moss.

Absent: Reps. Brett Roberts, Crawford, and Garcia.

Excused: Reps. Brett Roberts, Crawford, and Garcia.

Representative Dianda moved to approve the minutes of the May 4th, 2016 meeting.

There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

The chair laid HB 4838 and HB 4839 before the committee:

HB 4838 (VerHeulen) Occupations; registration; athlete agents; require registration and regulate agency contracts.

HB 4839 (VerHeulen) Occupations; licensing fees; athlete agents; establish registration fees.

Representative VerHeulen, along with David Bertram and Jenn Smith, representing Michigan State University, testified in support of the bills. Questions and discussion followed.

The chair laid HB 5577 before the committee:

HB 5577 (Leutheuser) Occupations; vehicles, dealers and repair facilities; dealer training and other general amendments to statute; provide for, and establish mobility dealer license certification.

Representative Leutheuser and David Richmond, representing the Secretary of State, testified in support of the bill. Questions and discussion followed.

Frank Waters, representing the Michigan Departments of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, testified on the bill.

The following people submitted a card in support of the bill but did not wish to speak:

Rebecca Devooght, representing the University of Michigan.

Kurt Berryman, representing Auto Dealers of Michigan,

Representative Dianda made a motion to excuse absent members.

There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

There being no further business to come before the committee, the Chair adjourned the meeting the time being 12:36 p.m.
