MINUTES OF THE COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION & INFRASTRUCTURE

May 5, 2015

Chair Pettalia called the meeting to order.

Chair Pettalia laid before the committee HB 4047 – Johnson – Highway; name; portion of M-18 between the city of Gladwin and the city of Beaverton; designate as the “Veterans Memorial Highway”.

Chair Pettalia recognized Rep. Johnson to explain HB 4047 and the substitute H-1, and to answer questions by members of the Committee on Transportation & Infrastructure.
