MINUTES OF THE COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION & INFRASTRUCTURE

May 12, 2015

Chair Pettalia called the meeting to order.

Rep. Glardon moved to approve the minutes from the meeting held May 5, 2015. The motion prevailed.

Chair Pettalia laid before the committee HB 4455 – Glardon –Highways; bridges; bridge inspection process; modify.

Rep. Glardon moved to report out HB 4455 with the recommendation that it pass. The motion prevailed, the vote being 16-0-0.

HB 4343 – Santana – Occupation; vehicles; dealers and repair facilities; penalties for acting as a motor vehicle repair facility with registration; revise.

HB 4344 – Pettalia – Occupations; vehicles; dealers and repair facilities; motor vehicle service and repair act; make general revisions.

Chair Pettalia turned the meeting over to Vice-Chair Glardon.

Vice-Chair Glardon recognized Rep. Santana to explain the substitute H-1 to HB 4343 and to answer question by members of the Transportation & Infrastructure Committee.

Vice-Chair Glardon recognized Chair Pettalia to explain the substitute H-2 to HB 4344 and to answer questions by members of the Transportation & Infrastructure Committee.

Chair Pettalia stated that the H-2 substitute was new to the committee as the Committee on Transportation & Infrastructure had adopted an H-1 substitute to HB 4344 at the meeting held on May 5, 2015.

Vice-Chair Glardon recognized George Carr representing Property Casualty Insurers stating a neutral position on HB 4344 and to question a certain piece of language in the H-2 substitute to HB 4344.

The following person filled out a testimony card in opposition to HB 4344 as currently drafted but did not want to testify.

Vice-Chair Glardon turned the meeting over to Chair Pettalia.

Chair Pettalia recessed the meeting to the call of the chair, the time being 11:20 a.m.
