The House Standing Committee on Criminal Justice was called to order by the Chair.

Members present: Reps. Heise, Webber, Courser, Lucido, Guerra, Hovey-Wright, Chang.

Members absent/excused: Rep. Howrylak.

Representative Lucido moved to adopt the March 24, 2015 minutes. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

The Chair laid HB 4314 before the committee:

HB 4314 (Singh) Traffic control; violations; operation of a motor vehicle on property open to public in a manner that would be a moving violation if on public property causing death or serious impairment of a body function; prohibit, and provide penalties.

Representative Singh introduced his bill, and submitted the attached letter. Questions followed.

Trooper Tim Fitzgerald, representing the Michigan Department of State Police, submitted a card in support of the bill.

The Chair laid HB 4248 before the committee:

HB 4248 (Afendoulis) Crimes; other; provisions relating to the playing of "The Star-Spangled Banner", use of contemptuous language under certain circumstances, use of indecent language in presence of women and children, and improper disposal of refrigerator; repeal.

Benjamin Green, Legislative Assistant for Representative Afendoulis, introduced the bill.

Representative Lucido moved to adopt substitute (H-1) to HB 4248. The motion prevailed 5-0-0.
