BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

The current rules establish the State’s regulations on the various schedules of controlled substances, and provide for licensing, security, records, distribution, and disciplinary procedures. The proposed rule changes would include gabapentin to the schedule 5 classification – narcotics added to non-narcotic compounds. This would also include provisions for added training for a controlled substance license and exceptions to prescriber-patient relationship required to prescribe certain controlled substances.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

2018-020 LR would not have a fiscal impact on any unit of state or local government.
