## **BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES**

These rules provide for the procedures of the Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Division of the Michigan State Police in enforcing laws that govern commercial vehicles operating in this state. This includes, but is not limited to, providing for public safety on state highways; supervise, regulate, and control the use of highways by motor carriers; and operating commercial vehicle weigh stations.

The proposed rule changes would update the current rule set to reflect the transfer of authority from the Michigan Public Service Commission to the Michigan State Police pursuant to EO 2015-10, as well as the 2015 updates to the Motor Carrier Act pursuant to 2014 PA 493.

## **FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES**

The proposed rule changes reflect current department procedures, which have been in effect since 2015, pursuant to EO 2015-10 and 2014 PA 493, and therefore would have no fiscal impact on the State or local units of government.
