BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

2015-012 LR would add a rule pertaining to the implementation of 2014 PA 343, which requires the promulgation of administrative rules to include training standards for identifying victim of human trafficking for specified licensed or registered health professions. Specifically, the new rule would delineate standards concerning the content, providers, modalities, and verification of the training required pursuant to 2014 PA 343.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

The rule added by 2015-012 LR would have a nominal fiscal impact to the extent that the department would incur costs to perform the additional step of verifying that applicants for licensure or registration had completed the training required by 2014 PA 343.
