This transfer request would transfer Federal authorization from the Hazardous Materials Programs line to the Commercial Vehicle Enforcement line to align authorization with available revenues based on higher than anticipated Federal Motor Carrier Safety Assistance Program funds. The funding would support efforts to assist in reducing commercial vehicle crashes, fatalities, and injuries through traffic enforcement and other safety efforts. Spending authority is available in the Hazardous Materials Programs line due to lower than anticipated Federal revenues.
