Total revenue collection for third quarter (May-July) fiscal year (FY) 2006-07 was lower than third quarter FY 2005-06 total revenue collection by $\$ 267.2$ million or $5.2 \%$. Fiscal year-to-date (FYTD), total revenue collection was down $\$ 81.7$ million or $0.6 \%$.

Income tax revenue consists of three components - withholding, annual payments, and quarterly payments. Withholding payments are based on workers' earnings and make up almost $85 \%$ of gross income tax collection. Annual and quarterly payments are based on self-employment earnings and other income sources, such as capital gains.

Net income tax collection (which includes income tax refunds) for third quarter FY 2006-07 was lower than third quarter FY 2005-06 collection by $\$ 10.1$ million or $0.6 \%$. Withholding payments were up $1.5 \%$, quarterly and annual payments were down $13.7 \%$ (due to timing factors), and refunds were down $0.7 \%$. Net income tax collection FYTD was $\$ 4.7$ billion-up $\$ 144.3$ million or 3.2\% from a year ago.

Sales tax collection is derived from the sale of taxable items such as motor vehicles, furniture, apparel, food consumed at restaurants, and other general merchandise. The use tax is applied to telephone services, leased motor vehicles, hotels and motels, gas and electric utilities, and remote sales.

Sales and use tax collections for third quarter FY 2006-07 were lower than the year-ago quarter by $\$ 115.6$ million or $5.4 \%$. Sales tax due to motor vehicle sales decreased $1.0 \%$; all other sales tax collection was down $5.3 \%$ in third quarter FY 2006-07 relative to the year-ago third quarter. Sales and use tax collections FYTD were down $\$ 100.4$ million or $1.7 \%$ from a year ago.

Single business tax is applied to the value added of business activities; insurance tax is based on insurance premiums. For third quarter FY 2006-07, single business and insurance tax collections were below the year-ago third quarter by $\$ 120.0$ million or $18.4 \%$. Single business tax collection FYTD was $\$ 1.5$ billion-down $\$ 105.4$ million or $6.4 \%$ from a year ago.
