Michigan Potato Industry Commission \$25,000,000

Section XXX (1) From the funds appropriated in part 1 for the Michigan Potato Industry Commission, the commission shall establish a statewide well monitoring network as recommended by the 2020 water use advisory council report that shall include all of the following:

- a. A network of a minimum of 500 geographically dispersed groundwater monitoring wells with at least 450 located at sites with existing high-capacity wells.
- b. Data collected from the wells shall be provided to the Michigan Geologic Survey and the State of Michigan. Data shall include but is not limited to:
 - a. Complete aquifer performance testing and analysis as specified in Public Act 451 of 1994 Section 32706c of Part 327 for a minimum of 450 wells.
 - b. Water level data for all wells.
 - c. Hydrogeologic detail for each well location.

(2) The commission shall contract with professional hydrogeologic consulting firm(s) to establish and maintain the network for three years of data collection.

(3) Monitoring at each well location shall provide continuous water level data with a measurement tolerance of 0.04 feet and a measurement interval of 60 minutes from a minimum of 500 wells for at least 3 years.
