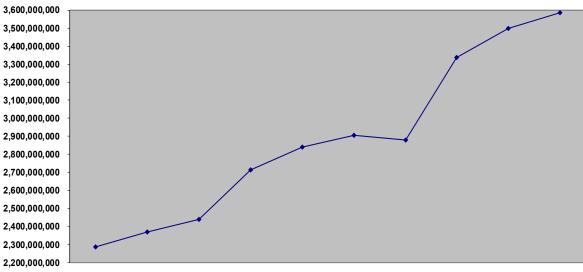

FY25 Governor's Recommendation

Investment

Operational Realignment and Filling of Vacant Positions

- Strategic realignment of positions by fulling funding and/or transferring positions across 6 line-items
- Funds 41 vacant positions
- Currently have approximately 80 appropriated unfunded FTE
- Fixed fee restricted revenue collections have not kept up with inflationary cost increases over the last 20 years
- Has resulted in backlogs, audit findings, and some unhappy customers and employees

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• Does not increase overall FTE included in the budget



FY25 Governor's Recommendation

Current Services Baseline Adjustments

10 FTE for Elections - \$1,145,000

- 8 FTE for New Financial Disclosure Requirements
- 2 FTE for Automatic Voter Registration Changes

License Plate Cost Increases

• \$1,146,500 from TAC Fund

USPS and UPS Rate Increases

• \$1,115,000 from TAC Fund

Contract Increase for Tabs, Decals and Forms

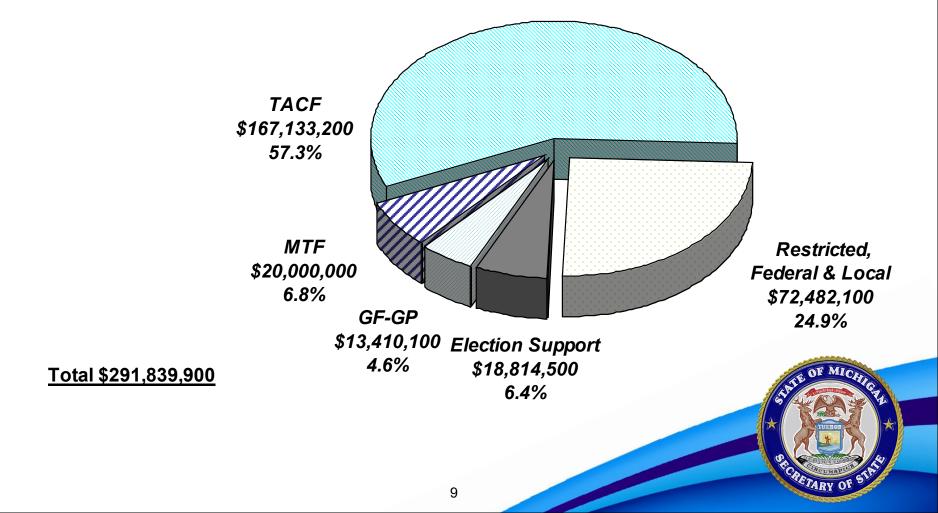

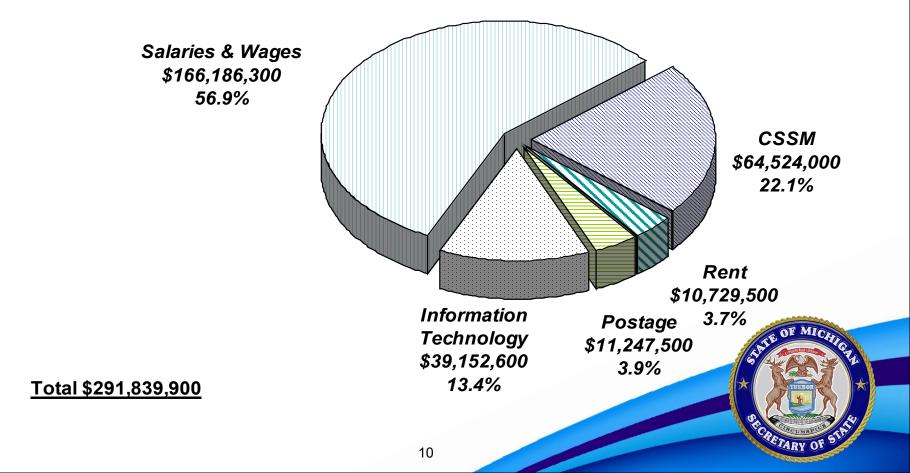

FY24 Supplemental Requests

HAVA Security Grant Authorization - \$5.7M

Grant funding received in FY22 and FY23 to support election security related initiatives

Financial Disclosure Requirements - \$831,900

 Partial year funding for 8 FTE to implement the new reporting that applies to elected officials and candidates for office

License Plate Cost Increases - \$1.1M

One-Time Lump Sum Payments - \$110,400 Special Elections Costs - \$750,000 in Treesury Bu

Unfunded Requests

Inflation Costs and Fee Sunsets

- Need statute changes to allow fee adjustments based on the consumer price index which would increase the record look-up fee, registration service fee and title service fee by \$1 every couple of years
- Eliminate the Transportation Administration Collection Fund fee sunsets

Driver's Education - \$45M General Fund

- Privatization has created financial and accessible barriers
- Number of licensed Michigan teens has decreased by over 10%
- Provide grants to families in need to afford access for teenagers
- Explore a return of driver's education to our public schools
