

# Management of Information Technology Shortfall

**Lean Process Improvement** in 2019.

DHHS/DTMB IT Governance Board implemented in Jan 2020.

Freeze on non-essential IT development.

Vendor concessions, contract renegotiations, and administrative reductions.

Increased financial oversight with detailed and timely vendor billing.

Freeze on most MDHHS & DTMB hiring.

## **Child Welfare IT Modernization**

Status in FY2022

#### Background

- Received \$16.8M Gross (\$8M GF) in FY 22.
- CSA process of transitioning from MiSACWIS to a Comprehensive Child Welfare Information System (CCWIS).
- Completed in phases, with full CCWIS compliance achieved by 2025.


#### **Progress**

- First Module Child Welfare
  Licensing & Foster Care Portal will be implemented in June 2022.
- Next modules Intake, Investigation
  & Foundational Framework.
  - The contracting process is in progress for FY 23 development.
  - Business Process Redesign & Human Centered Design began on February 15<sup>th</sup>.

# Home Help Payments Status in FY2022

#### **Background**

- Received \$21.0 million Gross (\$2.1 million GF).
- Home Help Program will transition from payment for services authorized to a federally mandated payments for services provided in preparation for Electronic Visit Verification.
- 2019 OAG Home Help Performance Audit.

#### **Progress**

- The component of the project to address audit findings is close to completion.
- Moving Home Help payments into the MMIS (Medicaid Management Information System – CHAMPS) is in design stages.
- Analysis work on a comprehensive Electronic Visit Verification system is in progress.





## Child Welfare IT Modernization

#### **Context**

- Aging and failing IT system, MiSACWIS.
- Continue planned roadmap with recommended modular implementation.

#### Response

- Continue to develop and implement Release 2 modules: Intake, Investigation and Foundational Framework.
- Begin release 3 planning: Human Centered
  Design & Business Process Redesign.

#### **Expected impact**

- Improved outcomes for kids and families & caseworker satisfaction and retention.
- Improved data collection, data-driven decision making & assessment of program performance.
- Compliance with federal regulations.



## Vital Records Modernization

#### **Context**

- Marriage and divorce certificates are paper processes.
- Electronic Death Reporting System is aging and not widely used by physicians.
- Significant delays in registering and issuing vital records, and in compiling key vital statistics, including cause and location of death.

#### Response

- Addition of marriage, divorce, and death modules to Vital Events
   Registration Application (VERA), a platform adopted in 2020 for birth registration.
- Funded through DTMB Information
  Technology (IT) Investment Fund.

#### **Expected Impact**

- Improved availability of vital records to Michigan residents.
- Timely and accurate mortality data for public health.



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
