PERFORMANCE INDICATORS TASK FORCE

The FY16 community college appropriations budget (boilerplate language) outlines a task force for evaluating the current performance indicators used for appropriations as related to Michigan Community Colleges. This group would review, evaluate, discuss and make recommendations regarding the current list of performance funding indicators / methodology and consideration of other measures that would be the most appropriate and reliable for allocating state funding to those indicators.

“Sec. 230a. Performance Indicators Task Force – NEW

Senate requires creation by October 15 of a performance indicators task force to make recommendations on community college performance funding metrics. The nine-member task force would include representation from the legislature, state budget office, and community colleges, and would submit its report by January 15, 2016. Executive and House did not include. Conference concurs with Senate”

SVSU supports the idea of a task force made up of officials representing each public university, the legislature, state budget office, and would evaluate the performance indicators in the Michigan Higher Education Appropriations Budget, each fiscal year.
