

Thank you Chairman Kelly. My name is Doug LaFleur. I am the founder and president of Eidex. With me today is Tim Raymer. Tim spent his career as a school business official serving five Michigan districts. He is highly respected across the state, and now works with Eidex users to help ensure that they are benefiting fully from our software.

I'd like to start by thanking the Committee for the opportunity to appear before you today. Your initiative to support the adoption of data analytics software by Michigan administrators has had a meaningful impact on public schools, particularly as it pertains to expenditures and financial health.

The success of this program is borne out by the number of districts that have participated. 410 LEA districts have adopted at least one of the three applications available under Section 102d representing 76% of all LEA districts in the state. Students attending these 410 districts account for 86% of all LEA students in Michigan.

There are three important benefits to our software that I'd like to briefly share with you:

1. **Cost savings.** Through peer comparisons, administrators have the opportunity to scrutinize expenditures that are out of line with peer averages.
2. **Reallocation of resources.** Often times, by reducing non-instructional expenditures, scarce dollars can be redirected to where they really count: classroom instruction.
3. **Time savings.** Our users routinely tell us how much time they are able to save using Eidex.

We've prepared a report for the committee summarizing the results of the your initiative which we invite you to review. As a part of this report, we've compiled commentary from Eidex users.

George Heitsch, superintendent of Farmington Public Schools, in particular, asked us to share with you how he has benefited from using our software. Superintendent Heitsch states that, and I quote, "over the past two years, Farmington Public Schools has used Eidex to help realign resources and staffing to reflect our district's declining enrollment. This helped us rebuild our fund equity to 9%. Eidex played a critical role in the success that we have experienced in reallocating valuable resources."

This endorsement is indicative of positive feedback we've received from users throughout the state. In summary, we support your vision to facilitate the effective and efficient use of data by school administrators to support their mission of achieving improved student outcomes.

I'd now like to ask Tim to share his perspective.

RE: Section 102d

Thank you for the opportunity to discuss this important issue.

I spent 36 years as a school business official in five Michigan districts including rural, suburban, urban, and intermediate school districts. I understand the importance of data in decision-making, but also the challenge of accessing that data. Data analytics has changed this landscape dramatically as it allows districts to focus on key issues. The use of technology to collect large amounts of data and put it into a tool to analyze for improved decision-making has improved the quality of decisions as well as the time required to make decisions. Key to the growth of school district data analytics in Michigan was the Legislature's vision and commitment with section 102d. This support is critical for making access to quality data for district decision-making a realistic option. Absent funding for section 102d districts face greater challenges regarding allocation of resources. The 102d funding provides important support for school districts.

School districts are in a constant state of resource allocation. Financial, human, and individual time resources are finite and district officials need every tool possible to make quality decisions. Data analytics tools are critical to the process as they allow for multi-perspective analysis of large amounts of data, empowering districts to focus on areas of need, and minimize the time spent on areas requiring less attention. Whether it is monitoring trends or analyzing comparable data of similar peer districts the use of these tools to address an overwhelming amount of data is invaluable.

I am a big supporter of section 102d and its value to school districts. A related piece of

legislation helpful to school districts is the Early Warning legislation of 2015 which coordinates well with 102d. This pro-active legislation has impacted the school financial landscape – positively in my opinion. Paul Conners and his Treasury team have enhanced the legislation with their implementation efforts. They are supportive and act in the best long-term interest of districts encouraging a sound and stable financial operation. This is an excellent example of long-term constructive thinking. Eidex advocates long-range planning and pre-emptive action to address unsustainable trends. We are expanding the product to better support Early Warning, as well as provide additional anticipatory data to school districts to minimize the instances of Treasury contact regarding financial issues.

I recognize you have more demands on resources than resources available. You have many options on where to invest funds. I hope you consider the "return on investment" and the leverage afforded districts when they have the tools to analyze large amounts of data quickly. Tools that support sustainable trends and identify unsustainable trends. Data driven decisions are necessary for school district success and the legislature's support and commitment with section 102d funding has been important in helping districts achieve this goal. We appreciate your past support as well as your future consideration.

Summary

- Eidex serves 277 of the 410 LEA districts that participated under Section 102d in 2016. These 277 districts account for 51% of all LEA districts in Michigan.
- Nearly 850,000, or 64%, of Michigan's 1.33 million LEA pupils attend an Eidex subscribing district.
- Fourteen ISDs have contracted with Eidex.
- Across the state, we serve 11 of 16 districts with greater than 10,000 students, and 46 of 63 districts with greater than 5,000 students.
- Eidex is actively utilized by Michigan administrators to reduce expenditures, increase fund balances, and as a means for conducting more effective teacher and staff negotiations.
