Mi roads by the #s ...

Counties = 90,000 mi. (74%) Municipal = 22,000 mi. (18%) MDOT= 10,000 mi. (8%)

Mi bridges by the #s ...

Counties = 5,724 (52%) MDOT = 4,700 (42%) Municipal = 700 (6%)


Quick fact: Michigan has the 4th-largest system of local roads in the US.

Michigan Transportation Fund (MTF)






PERCENTAGE OF SYSTEM

\$1.1 billion goes to MDOT


2015 Transportation Funding: Reporting Back.



How New Road Dollars Are Being Used

CRA survey shows 81% of "new funds" from 2021 going to roads, bridges, ROW.

In 2021 85% matched township funds or gave stipend.



- Roads 73%
- Bridges 8%
- **Equipment** 9%
- **State-mandated unfunded liabilities** 5%

- Staff 1.5%
- Building/facility improvements 1.5%
- Other 2%

Cost of common county road repairs.





Path Back to "Good" Local Roads, Bridges

CRA's suggestions for a road funding solution include:

- Phase II of road funding.
- Constitutionally-protected funding, fully indexed to inflation.
- Retention of PA 51.
- Begin to pilot electric vehicle revenue model.


Findings of County Road Investment Plan

Findings of County Road Investment Plan

Looking at monetized needs on county road system in 6 areas:

- Federal Aid Roads Mich. Tech., PASER, 15%/yr.
- Nonfederal Aid Roads 15% of road miles/yr.
- Road Maintenance snow, ROW, trees, guardrail, potholes
- Bridges 50-yr. lifespan
- Equipment basic needs to do work
- Buildings, Maintenance Facilities all types, 40-yr. lifespan

Less current spending

Additional \$ needed to reach goals =

\$764,613,642 \$1,516,405,856 \$912,903,033 \$222,177,467 \$164,615,464 <u>\$44,624,483</u> **\$3,625,366,945** - \$1,734,106,480 **\$1,844,000,000/yr.**


Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act – IIJA
