

**Tuition Reciprocity Agreement**  
**July 1, 2015 – June 30, 2017**  
**Between**  
**Owens Community College**  
**The University of Toledo**  
**And**  
**Eastern Michigan University**  
**Monroe County Community College**

This tuition reciprocity agreement allows residents from Monroe County, Michigan to attend the University of Toledo and Owens Community College located within the State of Ohio at the same in-state tuition rate that Ohio residents pay at either institution. Likewise, Ohio residents benefit from in-state tuition rates at Eastern Michigan University and out-of-district tuition rates at Monroe County Community College. This agreement expands access to programs that may not be available in-state, yet are offered out-of-state at an in-state tuition rate as well as promotes the use of existing facilities and programs in a neighboring state. Such agreements allow state higher educational institutions to invest their limited dollars into a more narrowed concentration of majors. The historical enrollment headcounts and current per credit hour tuition rates shown below demonstrates there are more Monroe County residents benefiting from the agreement at a significant higher cost savings than Ohio residents attending Eastern or Monroe under the agreement.
